Operation:

- 1. Connect to any RED® KOMODO™ camera by connecting directly to BP Mount.
- 2. The battery can then be inserted into the mount plate to provide a direct connection to accept battery packs.
- 3. Once the battery is connected, the LED will indicate the presence of voltage passing through the plate
